GENERAL INFORMATION

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Gastroenterology and Hepatology Symposium is designed for healthcare providers managing chronic gastrointestinal and liver diseases as well as patients/loved ones who face such conditions on a daily basis. This continuing medical educational activity will cover the latest updates in the management of Helicobacter pylori infection, pancreatic cysts, liver diseases, GI motility disorders and inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) to help community based providers improve knowledge, performance, and patient outcomes.

Emory Division of Digestive Diseases will showcase cutting -edge diagnostic and therapeutic procedures available at Emory to community gastroenterologists and other healthcare providers to improve care for their patients. Patients/ loved ones will also benefit by attending a patient - centered session that covers topics such as pancreatic cancer and colon cancer screening.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Gastroenterologists, Family Practice and Internal Medicine Physicians, Physician Assistants, PharmD, Nurse Practitioners, Nurses, Patients with GI disorders and their loved ones.

At the conclusion of this course, the participant will be able to:

- Review the clinical presentation, diagnosis and treatment options of common gastrointestinal and liver diseases;
- Discuss the management and treatment options of dysphagia and gastroesophageal reflux disease;
- Recommend the best evidence based treatment plan for esophageal diseases, H. Pylori infection, gastric intestinal metaplasia, GI motility disorders, pancreatic cysts, idiopathic pancreatitis and difficult colonic polyps;
- Understand the pathophysiology and novel treatment options for inflammatory bowel disease;
- Be familiar with the dietary and pharmacological management of functional gastrointestinal disorders;
- Compare the options for colon cancer screening;
- Discuss the management of patients with liver disease, including NAFLD and cirrhosis;
- Review the use of living donors and Hepatitis C positive donors in liver transplant.
