Our Faculty is led by Professor P-J Wormald who has a Rhinology interest. Professor PJ Wormald is a recognized international leader and expert in rhinology. One of his major interests has been the development of new techniques for teaching endoscopic sinus surgery anatomy and techniques. He is widely acclaimed as a teacher of excellence and is invited to lecture nationally and internationally.

The rest of the Faculty is made up of very experienced and highly trained surgeons, most of whom have done Rhinology Fellowships. This blend of youth and experience ensure a high level of experienced supervision for all dissectors.

**P R O G R A M**

The course will be run over two and half days including three live surgery cases and 8 hours of frontal sinus dissection

**NEW**

- World-first **non-cadaveric** course utilizing cutting edge 3D printed anatomical sinus models, with realistic tissue reconstruction.
- Anatomical models have been printed from real patient CT scans, with varying degree of difficulty.
- Candidates will be shown to plan frontal sinus dissections, using SCOPIS building block software, perform their surgery and then view recordings of the real-life surgery performed

**NEW**

- Candidates will have their own endoscopic stacks and equipment, with no sharing of stations
- Candidates will receive 6 3D models with CT scans allowing dissection of 12 frontal sinuses and 6 frontal drillouts.
- Dissection time has been increased to 8 hours for each candidate

**NFW**

- This year, in addition to a DCR and bilateral FESS, live surgery demonstration of the frontal drillout will also be performed
